

### Child & Youth Programming – Kayla

From fancy tea parties and explosive science clubs to sweet toddler Storytime's and intense Mario Kart races, we are offering the kids in our communities lots of opportunities to learn, grow, and make new friends! Over 200 kids and their parents have attended our programs in January 2024, and we look forward to offering exciting programs for the rest of the year!

### Adult Programming – Kimm

The library's jigsaw puzzle contest fundraiser went very well, with 9 teams competing on Saturday, Jan 27. The first pop-up program in Neustadt at Hillside Manor was also a resounding success, with 12 seniors and their visitors completing a needle-felted snowman. And plans are afoot for both a trivia night fundraiser and young-adult (18-24 years) book club and for Ayton, in March and April, respectively. Approximately 162 adults took part in January's programs and events.
